

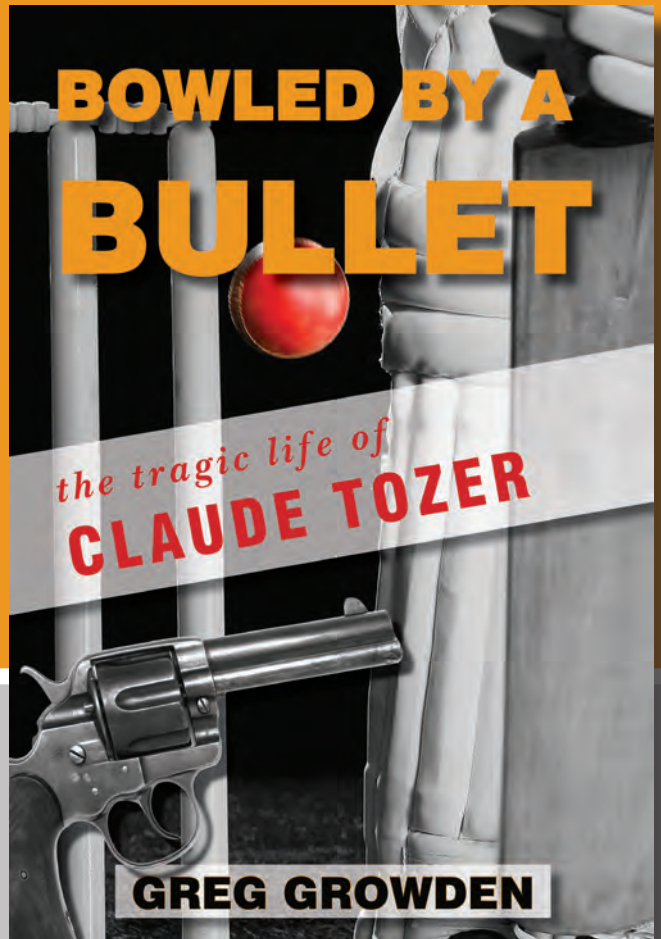
BOWLED BY A BULLET
