




Like a good cricketer starting an innings, broadcaster and author Bill Francis has edged towards double figures in his writing life. *In Pursuit of Excellence – The Barry Sinclair Story* is his 10th book and his fourth on cricket, following on from biographies of Tom Lowry, Sydney Smith and the co-authored publication with Ronald Cardwell, *The Team that Never Played*. *Cricket’s Mystery Man – The Story of Sydney Gordon Smith* was listed by MCC and English Cricket Society for its 2015 Book of the Year and his most recent book, *Peter Montgomery – The Voice of Yachting*, became the best-selling New Zealand non-fiction book.

In the 2016 New Year’s Honours, Bill Francis was made an Officer of the New Zealand Order of Merit (ONZM) for services to broadcasting and cricket.
